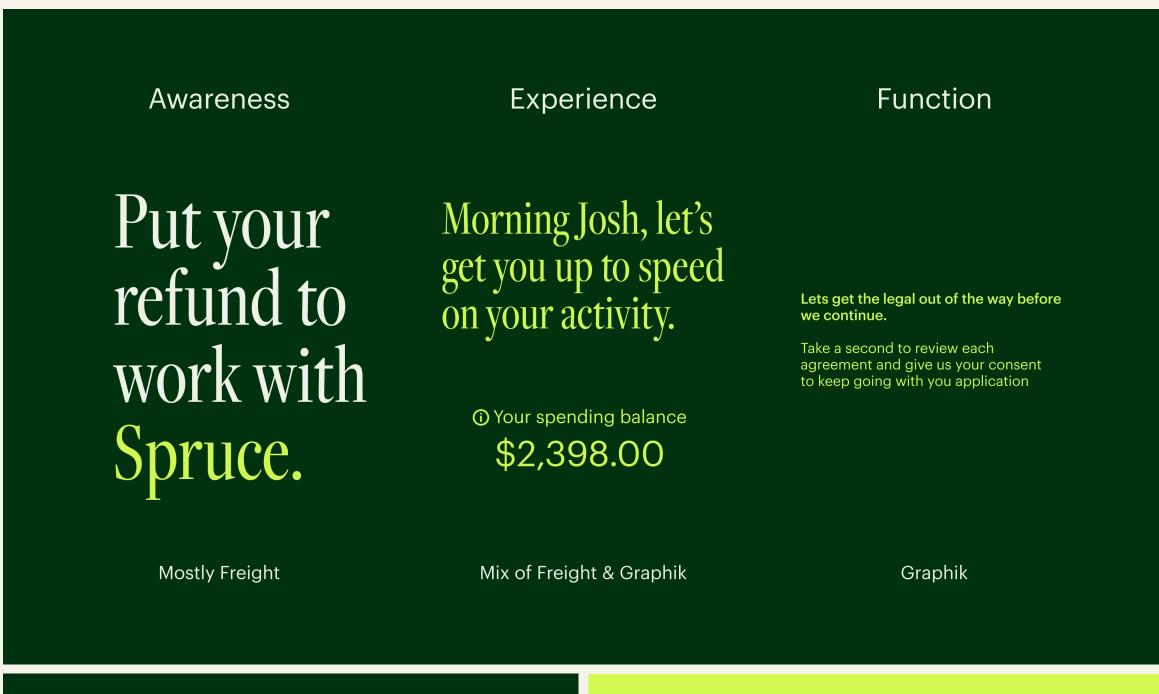
## **TYPOGRAPHY**

## **Overview**

We have replaced the font with 3 styles of <u>Freight</u> (FreightDispCmp Pro - Book, FreightDispCmp Pro - Medium, FreightDispCmp Pro - Semibold) which can be accessed now through an Adobe Creative Cloud account. FreightDispCmp Pro - Book will be the more forward-facing brand font from a marketing perspective.
