Dear Taxpayer:

We are confirming on Aug. 12, 2017, a Personal Identification Number (PIN) was established for your account.

You must enter the six character PIN when using IRS automated self-service applications on the telephone and Internet.

If you aren't aware of or didn't establish this PIN, please call us immediately at 1-800-829-0922 for assistance. You can also call us to change or restrict your PIN if you believe someone else knows your PIN and might try to access your account information.

The PIN you established allows access to your personal federal income tax information, so safeguard it and remember it for future use. The PIN is known only to you, won't be printed on any IRS correspondence, and won't be known by any IRS employee. There are civil and criminal penalties for any unauthorized use of the PIN to access your account.
