## If you don't agree with the changes

- You can contact us by mail. Fill out the Contact information section, detach, and send it to us with any correspondence or documentation.
- If you contact us in writing within 60 days of the date of this notice, we will reverse the change we made to your account. However, if you are unable to provide us additional information that justifies the reversal and we believe the reversal is in error, we will forward your case for audit. This step gives you formal appeal rights, including the right to appeal our decision in court. After we forward your case, the audit staff will contact you within 5 to 6 weeks to fully explain the audit process and your rights. If you do not contact us within the 60 -day period, you will lose your right to appeal our decision.
- If you do not contact us within 60 days, the change will not be reversed. You may then file a claim for refund. You must submit the claim within 3 years of the date you filed the tax return, or within 2 years of the date of your last payment for this tax.
- If we don't hear from you, we'll assume you agree with the information in this notice.
